AM Language offers courses in the English language at 6 levels:

Beginner, Elementary, Pre-intermediate, Intermediate, Upper-intermediate and Advanced.

These correspond to the Common European Framework (CEF) which is a system of level indicators for language courses that is used throughout Europe:

Beginner (Pre - A1), Elementary (A1), Pre-Intermediate (A2), Intermediate (B1), Upper-Intermediate (B2), Advanced (C1).

A student attending a course at AM Language will be placed in a class depending on the type of course chosen and the level of the student. Our Placement Test must be completed online prior to arrival. Failure to fill in the test will mean completing the test on the first day at school resulting in the possible loss of the first 4 lessons at the student's own expense. No refund will be offered by AM Language.

Lessons can be in the morning, afternoon or evening depending on the course chosen, level of the course and availability. Courses start every Monday. Sessions are of 45 minutes duration. All courses include use of audio and other teaching aids. Certificates of attendance are issued at the end of the course.
